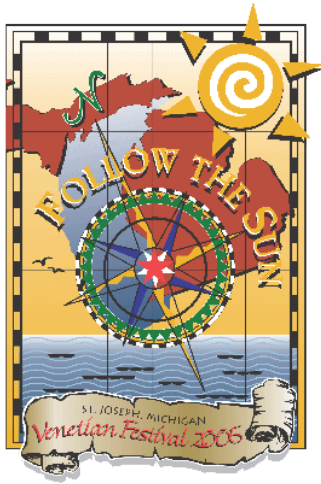
Grand Knight's Address
