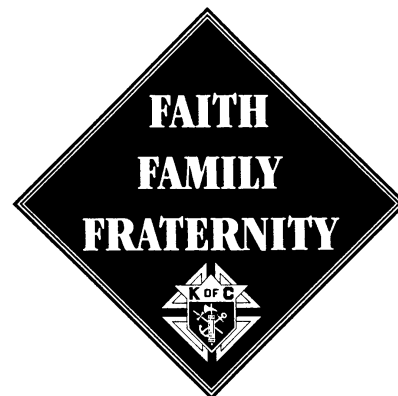
LADIES CORNER

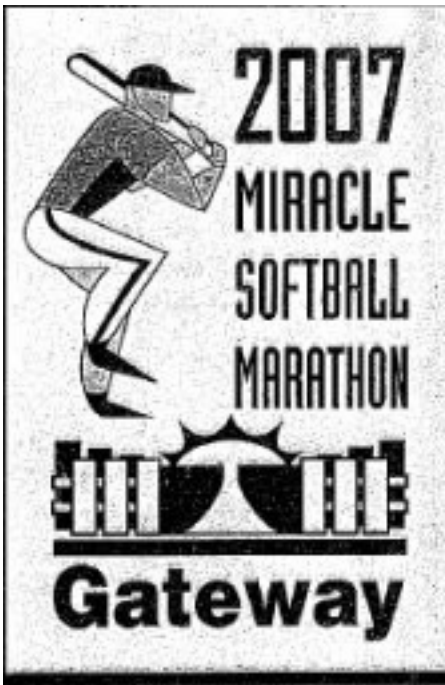

This is a fun, NON-COMPETITIVE event, each player receives a t-shirt, meal coupon, and entry into drawings for door prizes.

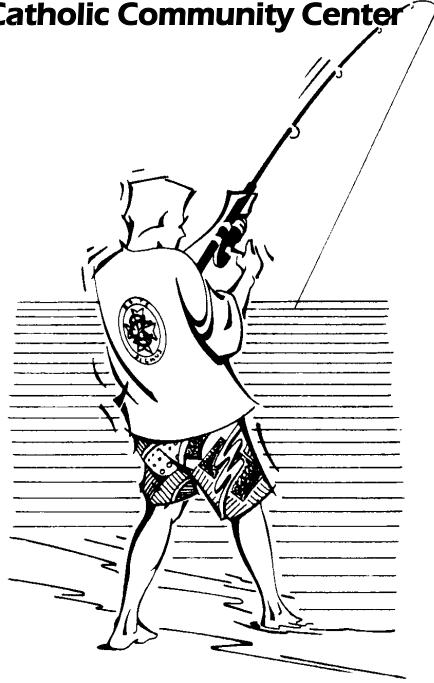
